Resources & Item Template Setup

The Resources area of B2W Estimate is the backbone of the estimating system. In Resources resides all of the information you use to form the cost basis of your estimates. It also includes crew templates and task templates that allow you to assemble reusable cost structures. In addition, Resources serves as a storage area for organizational information such as your customer lists, engineers/architects, subcontractors, and vendors.

Bid Closing

Another strength of B2W Estimate is its bid closing capabilities. The process occurs on three tabs where values can be determined for bond, overhead, profit, and when you chose to use indirects. Choose the pay items where the previously calculated values are to be distributed, and specify a method of distribution to be used. Perform distribution, and make any necessary manual adjustment to your item prices.
